12	WHEREAS, the City of South Fulton ("City") is a municipal corporation duly					
13 14	organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia;					
15	WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City is the Mayor and					
16	Council ("City Council");

18	WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter Section 3.13, the City Council shall meet at					
19	least once during each calendar month and hold regular meetings;

21	WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend its meeting procedures as set forth					
22	herein; and

24	WHEREAS, the City Council finds this ordinance to be in the best interests of the					
25	health, safety and general welfare of the City.

27	THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH FULTON HEREBY ORDAINS as					
28	follows:

29	Section 1: The City of South Fulton Code of Ordinances, Title 1, Administration,

31	hereby amended to read as follows:

33	Sec. 1-3001 Time, place for meetings; open meetings.

35	a. Compliance with Georgia Open Meetings Act. All meetings of the council shall					
36	be held in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 50-14-1 et seq., the Georgia Open Meetings					
37	Act. The Mayor, or presiding officer, shall adjourn all meetings where there is no					
38	quorum present within the first thirty minutes of the scheduled start time of the					
39	meeting.

41	b. Meetings Schedule. Unless cancelled or rescheduled by a majority vote of City					
42	Council, the City Council shall meet on the second and fourth Tuesday of every					
43	month as follows:

45	1. Work Sessions, beginning at 1:00 p.m.;					
46	2. Executive Sessions, beginning at 4:00 p.m.; and

3. Regular Sessions, beginning at 5:00 p.m.; 47 48 c. Break Between Sessions. Unless cancelled or rescheduled by a majority vote of 49 City Council, the City Council shall observe a break from 4:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. 50 (between the Executive and Regular Session) to meet with constituents and/or 51 handle personal business. 52 53 d. **Proclamations and Zoning Hearings.** Unless held otherwise by a majority vote 54 of City Council: 55 1. Proclamations shall be set for the second Tuesday of every month. No 56 member of City Council, including the Mayor, shall be allowed to be the 57 first/lead sponsor or more than one proclamation per meeting. They may 58 however be secondary sponsors on up to seven (7) proclamations per 59 meeting; and 60 2. Council zoning public hearings shall be set for the fourth Tuesday of every 61 62 month. 63 64 e. Endpoint for Meetings. Unless held otherwise by a majority vote of City Council, no City Council meeting shall run beyond 8:30 p.m. Any unfinished business of 65 any such meeting shall be placed on the agenda of the next scheduled meeting of 66 its type (i.e. unfinished business from a Work Session shall be placed on the 67 agenda of the next Work Session, unfinished business from a Regular Session 68 shall be placed on the agenda of the next Regular Session Meeting). 69 70 f. **Council Comments**. At the end of Regular and Special Called Meetings, each 71 member of City Council shall have three minutes each to make closing comments 72 73 and announcements. 74 g. Preferred Special Called Session Times. When Special Called Sessions are 75 needed, the first vote shall be for the Special Called Meeting to occur at 1 p.m. on 76 the first Tuesday following the poll, unless said Tuesday is the date of General, 77 Runoff or Special Election Day in which residents of the City of South Fulton are 78 eligible to cast votes. 79 80 h. Deference for Elections. City Council shall not hold any meetings on a General, 81 Runoff or Special Election Day in which residents of the City of South Fulton are 82 eligible to cast votes. 83 84 ****** 85 86 **Section 2.** It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Mayor and Council that: (a) 87 All sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are or were, 88 upon their enactment, believed by the City Council to be fully valid, enforceable and 89 constitutional. 90

(b) To the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence,
clause or phrase of this Ordinance is severable from every other section, paragraph,
sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance. No section, paragraph, sentence, clause
or phrase of this Ordinance is mutually dependent upon any other section, paragraph,
sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

(c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance
shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise
unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is
the express intent of the City Council that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or
unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid,
unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining phrases, clauses,
sentences, paragraphs or sections of the Ordinance.

103 <u>Section 3.</u> All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby 104 expressly repealed.

<u>Section 4.</u> The city attorney and city clerk are authorized to make non-substantive
 editing and renumbering revisions to this Ordinance for proofing, codification, and
 supplementation purposes. The final version of all Ordinances shall be filed with the clerk.

108 <u>Section 5.</u> The effective date of this Ordinance shall be the date of adoption unless 109 provided otherwise by the City Charter or state and/or federal law.

<u>Section 6.</u> *Instruction to City Clerk*. Unless vetoed, the City Clerk is hereby directed
 to forward a copy of this Ordinance to the Department of Community Development and
 Regulatory Affairs.
