- (b) In the event that final revenue collections for any fiscal year fall short of ninety (90) percent of the estimated revenue collection for said year, \$500,000 of the \$1.5 million allocated for that year shall be retured to the General Fund to cover budget shortfalls. In the event that final revenue collections for any fiscal year fall short of eighty (80) percent of the estimated revenue collection for said year, \$1,000,000 of the \$1.5 million allocated for that year shall be retured to the General Fund to cover budget shortfalls.
- (c) This aforementioned monies in the City Hall Building Fund reserve account shall rollover from year-to-year and shall <u>only</u> be used for the purchase, grading and/or clearing of land for a City Hall complex or the design or construction of a City Hall complex. These monies shall not be used for any legal fees regarding the purchase of land.

- **Section 2.** It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that: (a) All sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are or were, upon their enactment, believed by the City Council to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional.
- (b) To the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is severable from every other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance. No section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is mutually dependent upon any other section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.
- (c) In the event that any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Resolution shall, for any reason whatsoever, be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the City Council that such invalidity, unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall, to the greatest extent allowed by law, not render invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of the Resolution.
 - <u>Section 3.</u> All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
 - **Section 4.** The City Clerk is authorized to make non-substantive editing and renumbering revisions to this Resolution for proofing, codification, and supplementation purposes. The final version of all resolutions shall be filed with the clerk.
 - **Section 5.** The **Effective Date** of this Resolution shall be the first of the next Fiscal Year (FY2024), which is s
