## **ORDER**

Petitioners The Honorable William "Bill" Edwards and the Honorable Helen Willis ("Petitioners") initiated the above-captioned matter by filing a Verified Application for Emergency Temporary Restraining Order, Interlocutory Injunction and Permanent Injunction on December 26, 2019. This matter is assigned to the Honorable Emily K. Richardson.

The Court has reviewed the pleadings of record and the supporting exhibits and, based upon the nature of the relief requested and the procedural posture of the underlying proceedings at issue, the Court does not find that a sufficient legal basis exists to grant an emergency restraining order to Petitioners in accordance with O.C.G.A. § 9-11-65(b). Moreover, the Court finds that in light of the timing of this action, the recent notification to Respondents of the

pendency thereof, and the existing conflicts of opposing counsel, an ample opportunity has not been provided for Respondents to respond to and be heard on the injunctive relief requested.

Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Petitioners' request for an emergency temporary restraining order is DENIED.

Petitioners are directed to follow up with the assigned Judge regarding any future hearings or rulings on the relief requested.
